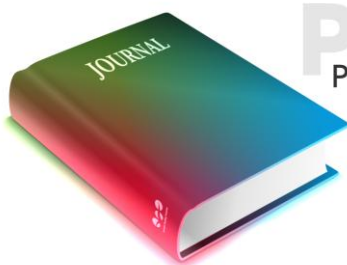

Fact Finding Sessions and Interactive Workshops

We've adopted a fresh approach for this year's Information Days. By shortening the general introduction to the Lifelong Learning Programme, we've been able to increase the time for focused workshops and information gathering. **This means you will be asked to choose three optional sessions on the day of the event**, including:

- **Two Fact Finding Sessions in the morning**

During the morning you will attend two brief Fact Finding Sessions of your choice. By the end of these sessions you should feel that you have basic knowledge of the opportunities available and of how to go about applying for them.

- **One Interactive Workshop in the afternoon**

In the afternoon you will attend one Interactive Workshop. The workshop allows you to explore in more detail one of the opportunities you investigated during the morning sessions. You will be able to discuss your ideas in detail with the ECOTEC team and hear from a representative of an organisation currently participating in Leonardo, Grundtvig or Transversal. You will also receive all the information you need about the application process.

Fact Finding Sessions and Interactive Workshop Themes

You can view the available Fact Finding Session and Interactive Workshop themes below. If you are not sure which themes are most suitable for you, don't worry. We will discuss this in more detail on the day.

Except where specified the topics below are available both in the morning (as Fact Finding Sessions) and in the afternoon (as Interactive Workshops).

New to the Lifelong Learning Programme (Fact Finding Session only)

We recommend you choose this session if you have never attended an Information Day before. The session will provide an introduction to the Lifelong Learning Programme and the kinds of activities we support.

Individual Mobility (Fact Finding Session only)

Here you will find out about how you can access professional development opportunities by sending individuals and employees involved in adult education to attend training courses, undertake work-shadowing and attend European conferences with funding from the Grundtvig (adult education) programme. This session will also cover short Study Visits for professionals involved in any area of lifelong learning.

Large Co-operation Projects

Transfer of Innovation projects allow UK organisations to work with European partners to transfer and adapt innovative vocational education and training materials and methods to different contexts (countries, sectors, target groups, subjects, delivery mechanisms etc).
